Ahmed had us exercise related to the image regarding perspective. What do you see? If you don't know something, you do research. Don't complicate things. Try to keep things simple to get early results. Simplicity usage takes practice.

Ahmed discussed **management versus leadership**. Ahmed recommends the audience consider taking a design thinking course to add to our **perspective** thinking tool bag. Ahmed spoke about the **purpose** and being part of our quality of life and its human. Finally, Ahmed conversed with the audience on their purpose ideas with Dave and Gus.



Ahmed concluded his presentation with the process: He focused on design thinking, the 4D process, creating a story (branding) about what your busy is, and limiting the number of hats you are wearing. Also, he wanted us to consider the **15-second rule** about what we do to share with others. He added to the **process** skill tools usage by considering a **balanced scorecard**. He added OKR or Objectives with Key Results to the conversation. Ahmed discussed **communication** with teams using models such as Tuckman's team development cycle, Google's high-performance team process, trust, conflict is good, and the **8 Cs of trust**.
